

Disposing of the Report on Correspondence

"It occurs to us that it is a peculiar method to dispose of the Report on Correspondence, which is the report of a regular committee, to authorize its publication with the proceedings. We think it should be received and ordered printed as an appendix, though some Jurisdictions, in addition to receiving it and ordering it printed, 'adopt' it, among this number Colorado. This, whilst very flattering to the author, is virtually adopting the opinions expressed by the correspondent, whereas in reality they may vary considerably from the consensus of opinion of the Grand Body, whose members never read it until months afterward, when it is in print, and therefore adoption is, in our opinion, a little too liberal an action to take."
