How shall we get the light out of the Chapter

"The real question is not so much how many Master Masons receive the light of these additional degrees; it is how shall we get the light out of the Chapter, out into the community, out into the world? My Companions, if Masonry, in any degree or body, has any real value, and we know it has, that value begins to make itself manifest when the final 'peace be with you' is said, and the members go out from the tyled and guarded 'place.' I am not at all concerned to have the Royal Craft make any ostentatious show in the world. I am very much concerned that it do its work in the world."
